Activating the SEA Service

The Copernicus Service in Support to EU External Action (SEA) can be activated only by Authorised Users. These include the European Commission services, the European Union's External Action Service, CSDP Missions and Operations, Member State Ministries of Defence or Foreign Affairs and intelligence centres, and elements within certain intergovernmental bodies, such as the United Nations' Department of Field Support (UN-DFS) or Department of Peace-Keeping Operations (DPKO).

The general decision scheme illustrated below presents the procedure for the Authorised Users to request an activation of the Copernicus SEA Service. An electronic copy of this document is available at https://sea.security.copernicus.eu/products/.

PRODUCTION SATELLITE IMAGERY SatCen requests imagery through the European Space Agency's CSCDA (Copernicus Space Component Data Access). Satellites and providers 1 are chosen based on their suitability for the request. The satellite provider(s) plan and execute the acquisition of the imagery and deliver the acquired imagery to SatCen. **IMAGERY ANALYSIS AND PRODUCTION** SatCen coordinates the production of geospatial intelligence products, which are carried out under contract by industrial partners. **DELIVERY AND PRIORITISATION** The European External Action Service, as SatCen delivers the product(s) to the user: Tasking Authority, examines the · HOW: Through a secure SatCen portal. sensitivity of the request, and - if it is approved - assigns a priority level. • PRODUCTS: A range of products is available, including First Impression Reports (FIRs), MapBooks and Digital Geospatial Information (DGI) Packages. The categories of products in the Product Portfolio are designed to satisfy a wide variety of user needs.

· FORMAT: Similarly, the products are available in various formats (e.g. printable maps, reports, layer groups).
